

Do you have Internet safety in your future? Fold this fortune teller to find out!



- Color and decorate the fortune teller (optional).
- 2 Cut it out. You will have a square.



Fold the square in half and then in half again.





Open the square with the blank side facing up. Fold each corner into the middle.



You will need +

- » Crayons (optional)
- » Fortune teller print-out
- » Scissors
- » Your trusted adult!
- 5 Flip the folded square over, and fold each corner into the middle again.





6 Flip over and fold in half.



Slide your thumbs and index fingers into the four flaps, and press together until they form 4 points.

Practice moving the flaps in and out. Now you're ready to tell your NetSmartz fortune!


Telling Your Fortune:



» Move the flaps in and out while spelling out the character's name. (Ex. Spell out C-L-I-C-K-Y and move the flaps 6 times.) » Open the fortune teller to reveal the numbers. Pick a number. Count out the number while moving the flaps in and out.

» Pick another number. Pick up the flap, and read the fortune underneath.


